Prepare Your HVAC for Winter with Preventative Maintenance

While the changing season provides a great opportunity for homeowners to save on HVAC costs by opening windows and temporarily powering down units, it will soon be time to turn on the heat.

Regular preventative maintenance, performed twice a year, can help your system keep up with seasonal temperatures.
Plus, it can increase HVAC performance and help you

avoid costly repairs. No one wants to be left with no heat in the winter months ahead. A quick tune up can greatly extend the life of your HVAC equipment, ensuring it is always running at peak efficiency.

Here are some steps you can take on your own that can result in a more comfortable winter:

Power down

Turn off all power to the unit before performing any maintenance; wait for the blower to stop.

Replace filters

Replace air filters at least once every three months. Dirty filters can cause your system to work harder, resulting in lower efficiency.

• Run a sound check

Turn your unit on, and check for unusual sounds, like banging or rattling.

Look for signs of moisture

Check for moisture on windows, or rust or dirt accumulations on the vent pipe. This can indicate improper operation.

Assess the room temperature

Check your thermostat's temperature while the unit is on to ensure rooms are reaching their full comfort potential.

Last year, Oliver helped a woman who has stage 4 breast cancer who is no longer able to work, a widow who is handicapped, on a fixed income with no family to assist her and a single mom who has health issues from contracting long Covid that prevented her from doing her job as house cleaner. In the last 23 years, we have completed over 74 heating installations at no charge to deserving families and individuals.

If you know someone who is struggling to keep their home safe and comfortable, write us a letter telling us about their situation.

Here is how it works:

- 1. Write a letter nominating a family or individual. You can nominate yourself.
- 2. Describe why the nominee deserves to receive a free heater..
- 3. Include medical circumstances, financial hardships, community involvement, and other circumstances that will help with the evaluation process.
- 4. Nominee must own their home and live in one of our service areas: Delaware County, Chester County, Montgomery County, and New Castle County
- 5. Include the nominee's full name, address and phone number. Include your full name, address, and phone number.
- 6. Deadline to receive submission is November 11, 2022. All information will remain private and confidential.
- 7. Selected nominees will be contacted by phone in mid-December.

Best Ever Butter Cookies

Ingredients

- 1 cup soft unsalted butter
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 egg
- 1 T orange juice
- 2 ½ cups flour
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 1 tsp baking powder



Preheat oven to 400 degrees

- 1. Combine butter, sugar and egg.
- 2. Beat at medium speed until creamy.
- 3. Reduce speed to low
- 4. Add flour, orange juice, vanilla and baking powder
- 5. Divide into thirds and wrap in plastic wrap
- 6. Chill 2 hours or overnight
- 7. Roll out on a floured surface to 1/8 to ¼ thick
- 8. Cut in shapes using a cookie cutter
- 9. Bake for 6-12 minutes on a cookie sheet until lightly browned
- 10. Decorate before or after baking

Frosting Ingredients

3 cups powdered sugar

1/3 cup unsalted butter

1 tsp vanilla

2-3 T whole milk

Instructions

- 1. Combine powdered sugar, 1/3 cup butter and vanilla
- 2. Beat at low speed, gradually adding milk for desired spreading consistency

Sewer Line Inspection Required for Your New Home


