## Heat for the Holidays Give the Gift of Comfort to Someone in Need



Since 1998, Oliver has been providing comfort to people who are in urgent need of a new heating system but are experiencing financial hardships that prevent them from purchasing one. We call our community outreach program, "Heat for the Holidays".

Last year, Oliver helped a single mother who works two jobs to support her teenage son and autistic 8-year-old. When her heater stopped working a few years, she could not afford to replace it and was struggling to keep her home warm in the winter. A granddaughter reached out on behalf of her widowed grandmother with limited income, whose heating system was over 30 years old and no longer keeping her house warm. In the last 25 years we have completed over 79 heating installations at no charge to deserving families and individuals.



If you know someone who is struggling to keep their home safe and comfortable, write us a letter telling us about their situation.

#### Here is how it works:

- 1. Write a letter nominating a family or individual. You can nominate yourself.
- 2. Describe why the nominee deserves to receive a free heater..
- 3. Include medical circumstances, financial hardships, community involvement, and other circumstances that will help with the evaluation process.
- 4. Nominee must own their home and live in one of our service areas: Delaware County, Chester County, Montgomery County, and New Castle County
- 5. Include the nominee's full name, address and phone number. Include your full name, address, and phone number.
- 6. Deadline to receive submission is November 10, 2023. All information will remain private and confidential.
- 7. Selected nominees will be contacted by phone in mid-December.

**CEILING FANS** – Flip the switch to reverse the spin of the fan and turn on the lowest speed to blow warm air down from the ceiling. Don't have one? We can help you with that.



## The Day after Thanksgiving is the Busiest Day for Plumbers!

The Friday after Thanksgiving is known as "Brown Friday" for plumbers. Kitchen sink clogs, jammed garbage disposals, main sewer clogs and toilet clogs are the major types of plumbing problems.

A houseful of guests means additional showers and baths, frequent use of toilets, washing machines, the kitchen sink and garbage disposal and this can strain your homes plumbing system – especially if there is already a partially clogged drain that was not noticeable.


#### **CLOG-PREVENTING TIPS:**

- 1. Never pour fats or cooking oils down drains.
- 2. Avoid putting stringy, fibrous or starchy waste in the garbage disposal. No turkey bones, potato peels, eggs shells, celery, or coffee grounds!
- 3. Don't wait until the garbage disposal is full to turn it on. Make sure it's running when you put food into it.
- 4. Wait ten minutes between showers so slow drains have time to empty.
- 5. Never flush cotton balls, swabs, hair, diapers, or wet wipes down a toilet, only toilet paper (and not too much).

## Gingerbread Partridge Cookies

#### Ingredients

3/4 cup sugar

3/4 cup shortening

2/4 cup molasses

2 T water

3 cups flour

1 T ground ginger

2 tsp cinnamon

1/4 tps salt

#### Instructions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees
- 2. Beat sugar, shortening, molasses and water until well blended
- 3. Combine dry ingredients
- 4. Gradually add to sugar mix
- 5. Cover bowl and let set at room temperature for 30 minutes
- 6. Roll out the dough on lightly floured surface
- 7. Cut into desired shapes
- 8. Bake 10-12 minutes until edges are lightly browned
- 9. Decorate before or after baking
